Our KICKOFF outreach events are always fun and full of excitement. Knowing the students will have a great time, our primary purpose is to preach the gospel to them. In our seven KICKOFF events so far this year, 631 students attended and, to God's glory, 31 responded to the gospel and 32 dedicated their lives to the Lord.

A Scripture teacher recently described our High School Scripture Seminar Team as paratroopers dropping in behind enemy lines to



come to the assistance of a lone soldier. This year we have been so blessed to be able to share the gospel with 1646 high school students in six different schools and to help encourage the Scripture teachers who teach the truths of the Word of God.

During the next few months, we will be on the road with our High School Ministry and KICKOFF outreach events. Your prayers will be needed as we plan to be in 15 schools and have 10 KICKOFF outreaches. Pray for open doors in the high schools, for the Christian youth to bring their unsaved friends to the KICKOFFS and for the Lord to touch the hearts of many young people.

The WOL PNG team will be hosting a health care team from the USA for two weeks. From Australia I have a pharmacist and a paramedic who will be joining the team. We will travel to Mt Hagen for the first week and then some of us will travel to Goroka for the second week. The purpose of the trip is to help with both the medical needs and spiritual needs of the people who come. Update On Lynda's Health

Lynda's eyesight has improved since she had her cataracts removed. Both of her surgeries and recovery time went well although she has scar tissue that has developed on both eyes, Her surgeon has done a laser procedure on one eye to remove the scar tissue and will need to do the second eye on 2 September.

We would like you to pray for Lynda's back pain and pelvic floor pain. Lynda has been seeing a pain specialist who believes a sacral nerve stimulator may help her back pain and, Lord-willing, might provide some relief to her pelvic floor pain. There are several steps we must undertake before Lynda has a permanent sacral nerve stimulator. The next steps are an

MRI, Training Day and a temporary sacral nerve stimulator trial. Lynda will be in the hospital for 10 to 14 days with the temporary stimulator in order for the doctor to monitor and adjust the nerve stimulation while Lynda undergoes rehabilitation. Lynda's hospitalization will begin on the 13th of September.
