There are many interesting contacts from my ministry on the Internet. Joel from Managua, Nicaragua wrote: "I just accepted Christ for the first time. I want my life to change

and separate myself from sin." Another time he asked, "Why do bad people see good things happen to them?" Ana from Medellín Colombia wrote: "I am sad, have no friends and estranged from family. The only thing I have are my cigarettes and they're killing me. Lord Jesus come into my heart and fill this emptiness." I've written to Ana three more times but she has not responded. Magaly from Valparaiso, Chile told of her severe depression, blaming herself for the suicide death of her husband. I answered her immediately and she wrote: "I was so impressed at your quick reply---like a miracle for me---and to think that someone from far away would write and encourage me." A month later: "Thank you, Beverly, for thinking of me. Your letters encourage me and I'm much better and happier." Lilly and I have been corresponding for over two years. She is from San José, Costa Rica and I've been able to give her lots of counsel over many difficult situations. She is the only Christian in her family, but she is firm in her faith and growing in Christ. Paulina from Colombia wrote of her struggle with depression and that seems to be a common theme with many. Also many ask for prayer to find a job. I try to encourage them with my reply. Thank you for your prayers for these and many others, and pray for wisdom for me in answering the many e-mails.
